Governor's Cup

Balboa Yacht Club is about to prove again that it is the center of the nation's and world's youth match racing as it hosts both the 58th Governor's Cup and the U.S. Youth Match Racing Championship for the Rose Cup this summer.

And, did you know that members of BYC founded both regattas!

The "GovCup" is the oldest and arguably the most prestigious youth match racing event in the world.

"GovCup" winners and crews have distinguished themselves in the America's Cup, the Olympics, World Match Racing Tour ("WMRT") and the Round the World Race. Three of the current top ten WMRT skippers are GovCup "alumni."



The Rose Cup

The "Rose Cup" was founded in 2010 as the "National Youth Match Racing Regatta" and named after two-time GovCup winner Andy Rose for his dedication to youth match racing. In 2015 it became an official U.S. Sailing Championship and returns to BYC for its 15th anniversary.

Only a handful of yacht clubs in the U.S. have ever had an event they created become a championship. BYC skippers have won 4 Rose Cups and two of them, David Wood and Jeffrey Petersen went on to become World Champions! This year, ten teams from all over the country will participate.



GovCupTV is a veteran 30-strong volunteer team of Club members who have raised the bar for live TV coverage of modern match racing worldwide. Which in 2024, included ten live shows on Facebook and YouTube with almost 10,000 views.

All told, the TV coverage alone delivered tens of thousands of impressions in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Western Europe, and, of course, the USA and

Southern California. This year, the team will cover <u>both</u> the Governor's Cup and Rose Cup action. Stay tuned for this year's schedule!



Press and Publicity



Not surprisingly, the Governor's Cup commands the best print and web-based coverage of any such event locally, nationally, and internationally. Sponsors gain visibility with the 900 Balboa Yacht Club members, and a wide Newport Beach and Southern California audience.

In addition to the GovCupTV exposure explained at right, the event is also covered by traditional press including Southern California newspapers, as well as print and internet publications worldwide.

GovCupTV produces a press release for each race day generally within an hour of the boats arrival back at the dock. These releases are picked up by the internet yachting press worldwide and lead sponsors are mentioned in each release. Our Sponsor Concierge will work with each sponsor to assure satisfaction.

Why Should I Become a Sponsor?

While sponsorship help is crucial to Balboa Yacht Club's ability to put on this world-class regatta—the Club only contributes about 15% of the budget—the "Sponsor Experience" includes some great "perks".
